- 156. Taral** – Taral is a soft and lilting name, meaning ‘liquid’.
- 157. Taras** – Taras, meaning ‘energetic or strength’, is perfect for a rough and tough young gentleman.
- 158. Tatpara** – Tatpara, meaning ‘deeply engrossed’, is one of the names of Lord Ganesha because He loves meditating.
