The bird comes to my window.

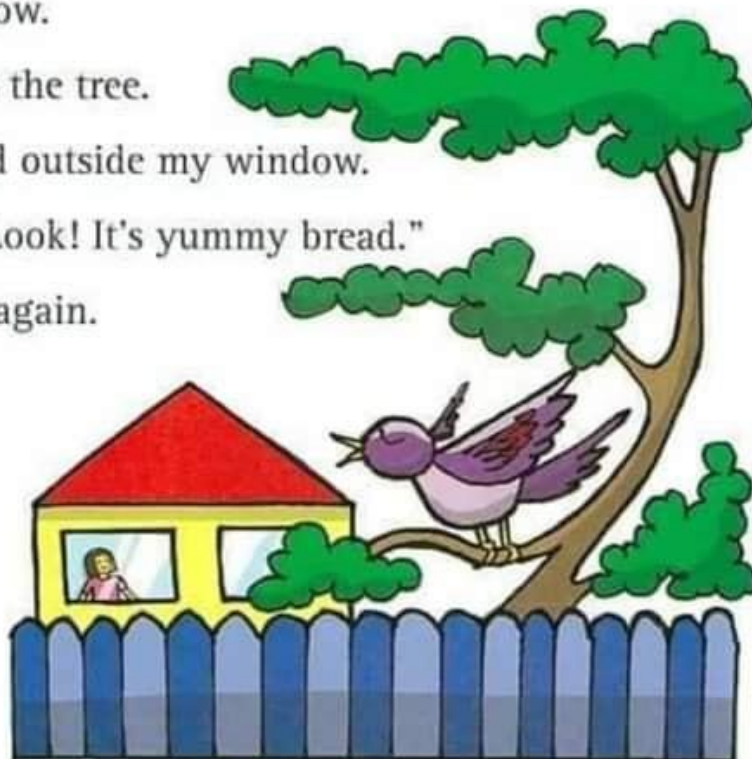
I open my window.

No, the toy is not there.

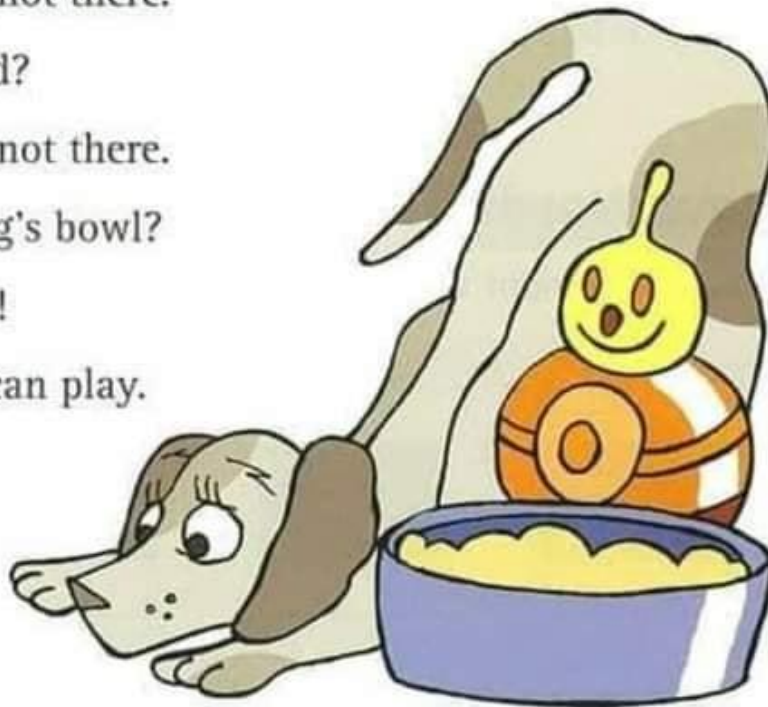
Is it by the bed?

He drinks milk from Pat's bowl for breakfast.

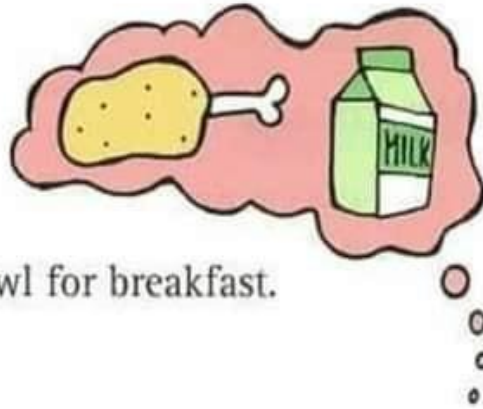
Then he eats cat food.

They sell green ones.

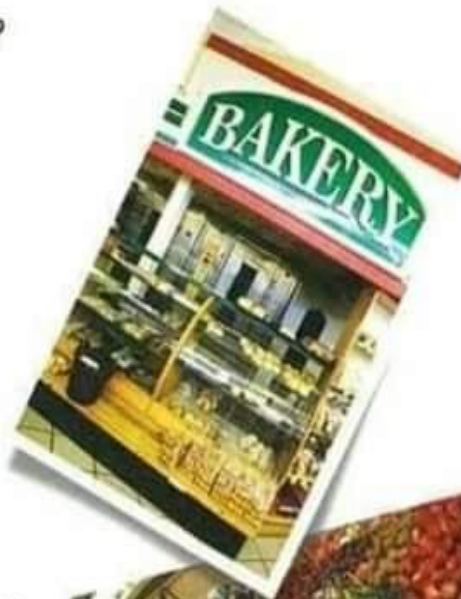
Which look good?

I like cheese, too.

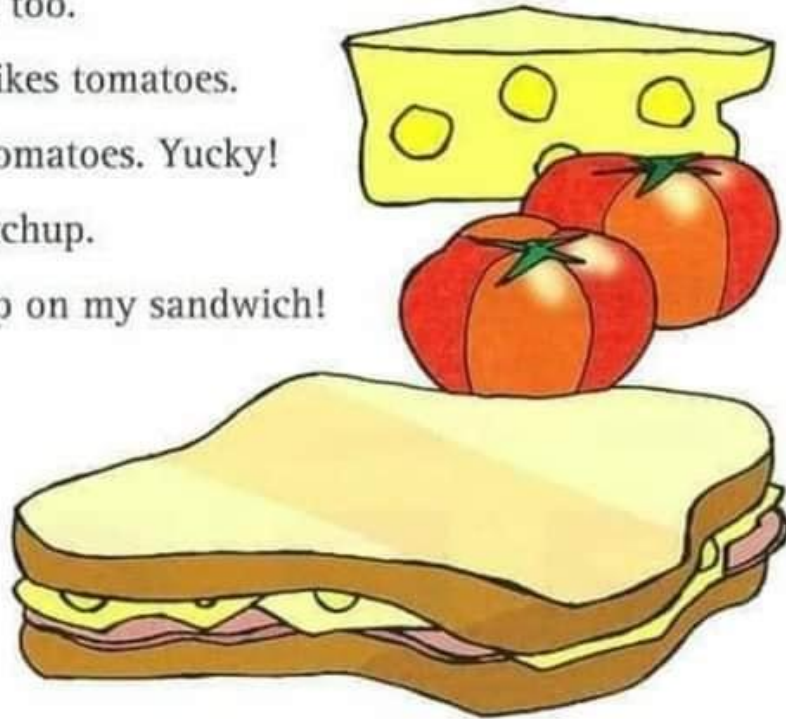
My mother likes tomatoes.

My friend John lives in the country.

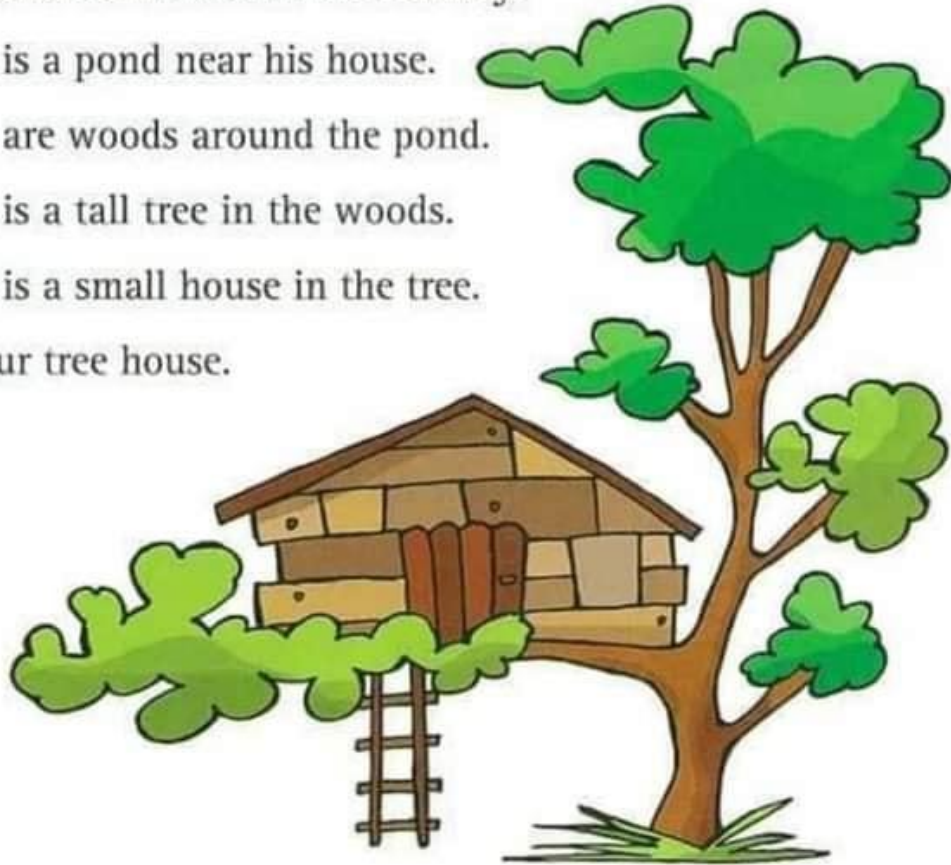
There is a pond near his house.

They run through the yard.

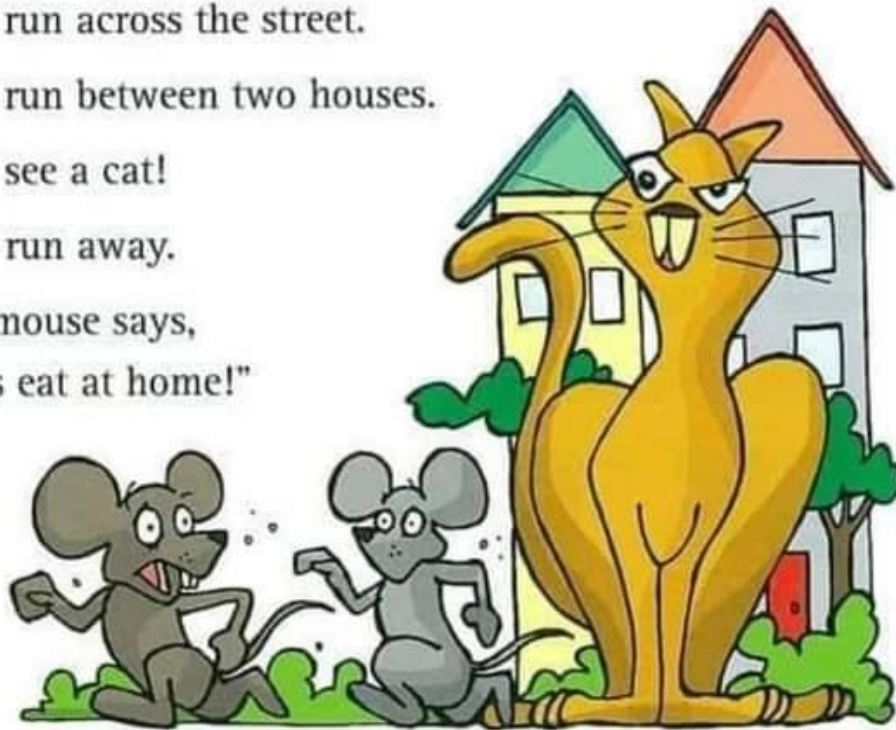
They run across the street.

The butterfly lands on the flower.

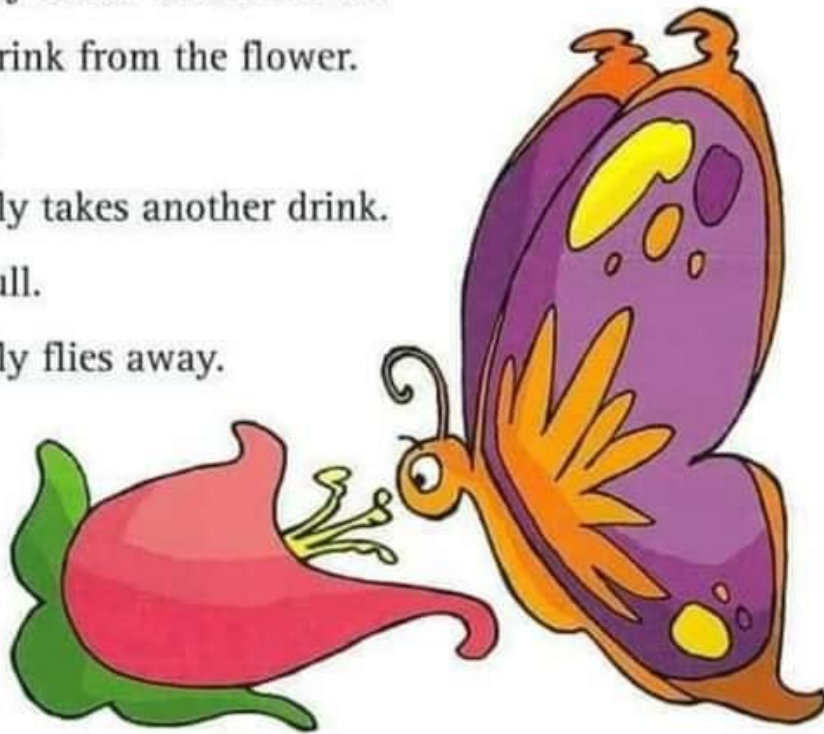
It takes a drink from the flower.

His room is a mess!

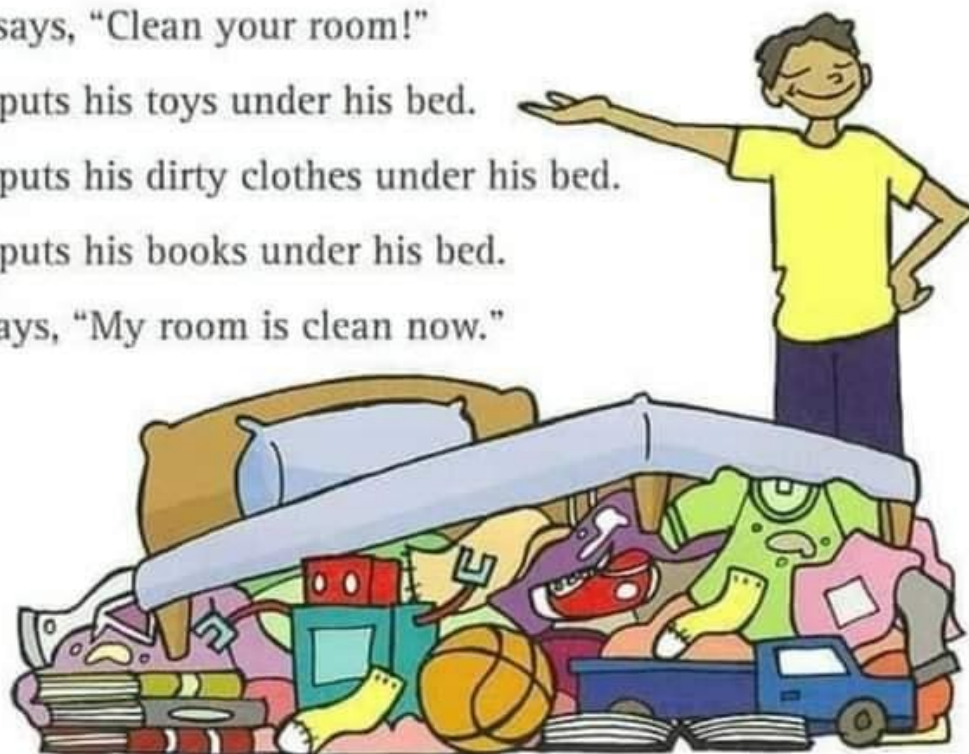
She says, "Clean your room!"

Bob puts his books under his bed.

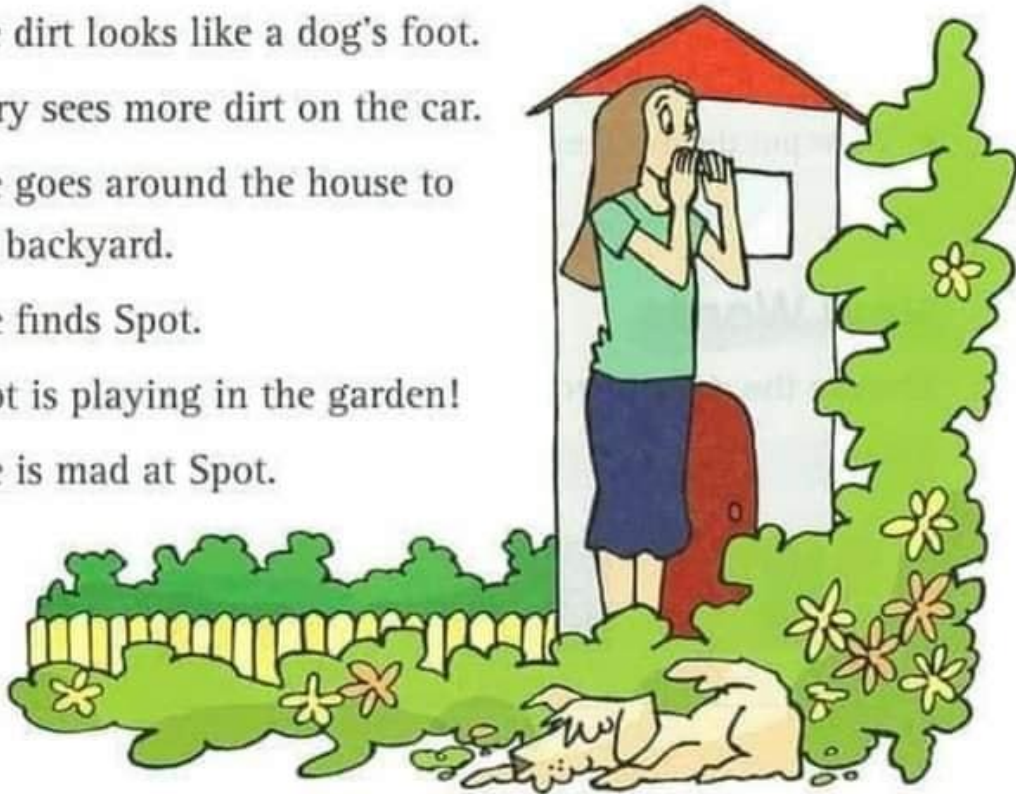
He says, "My room is clean now."

They walk over sticks.

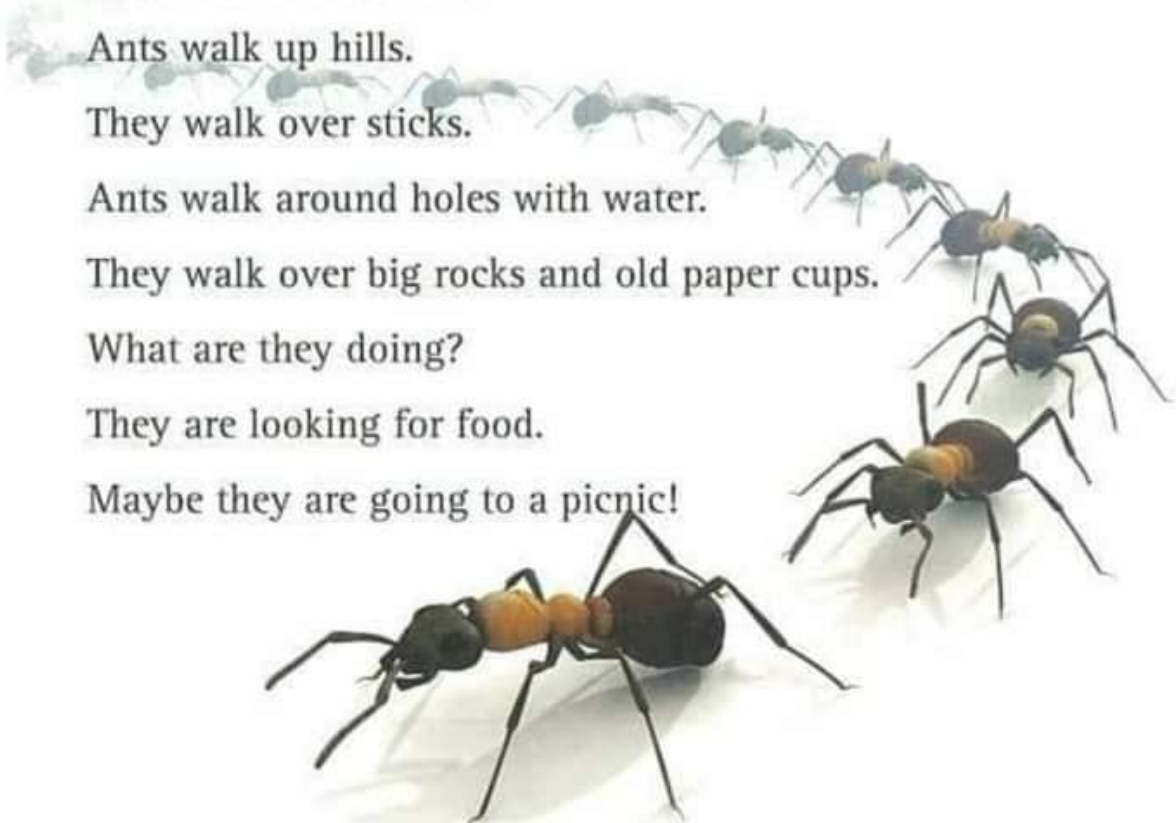
Ants walk around holes with water.

I wash my face.

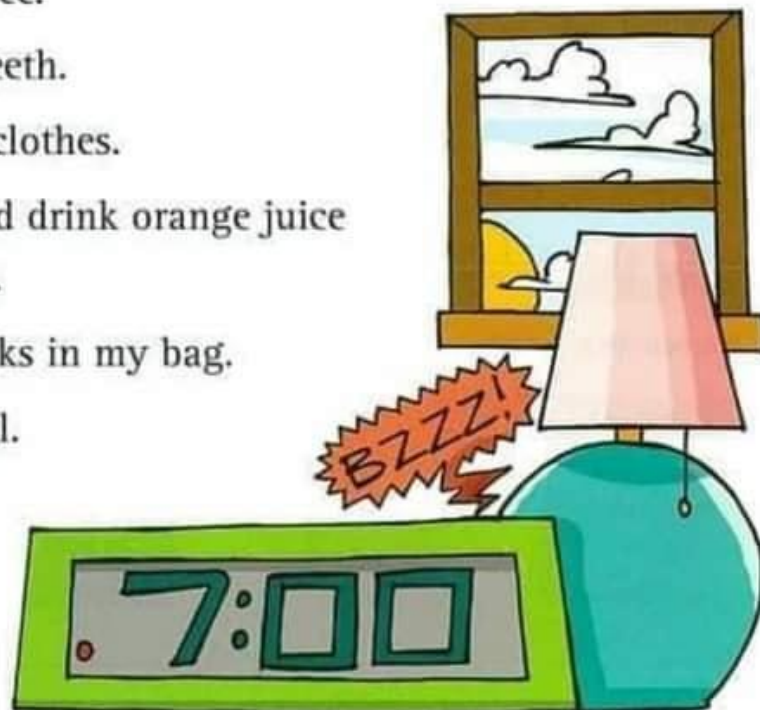
I brush my teeth.

His bike has big wheels.

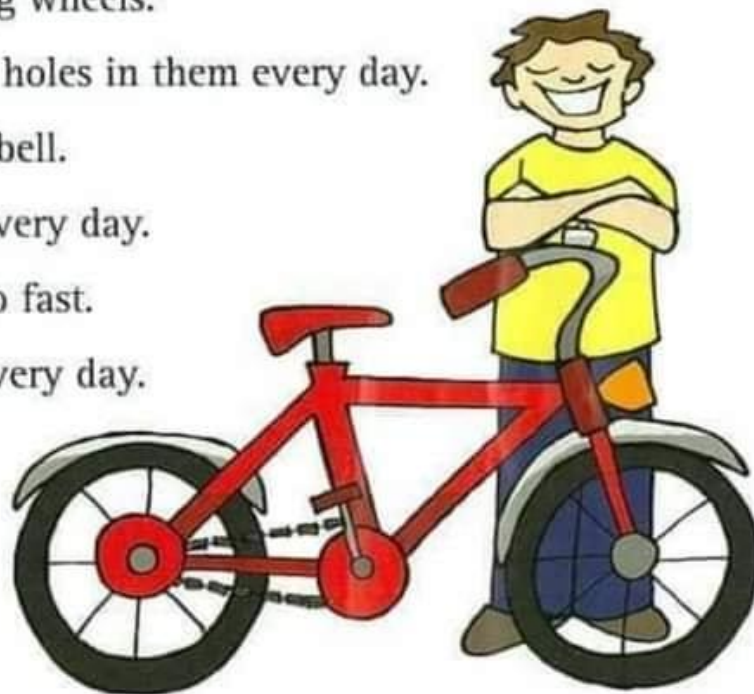
Mike looks for holes in them every day.

There are sandwiches. Yummy!

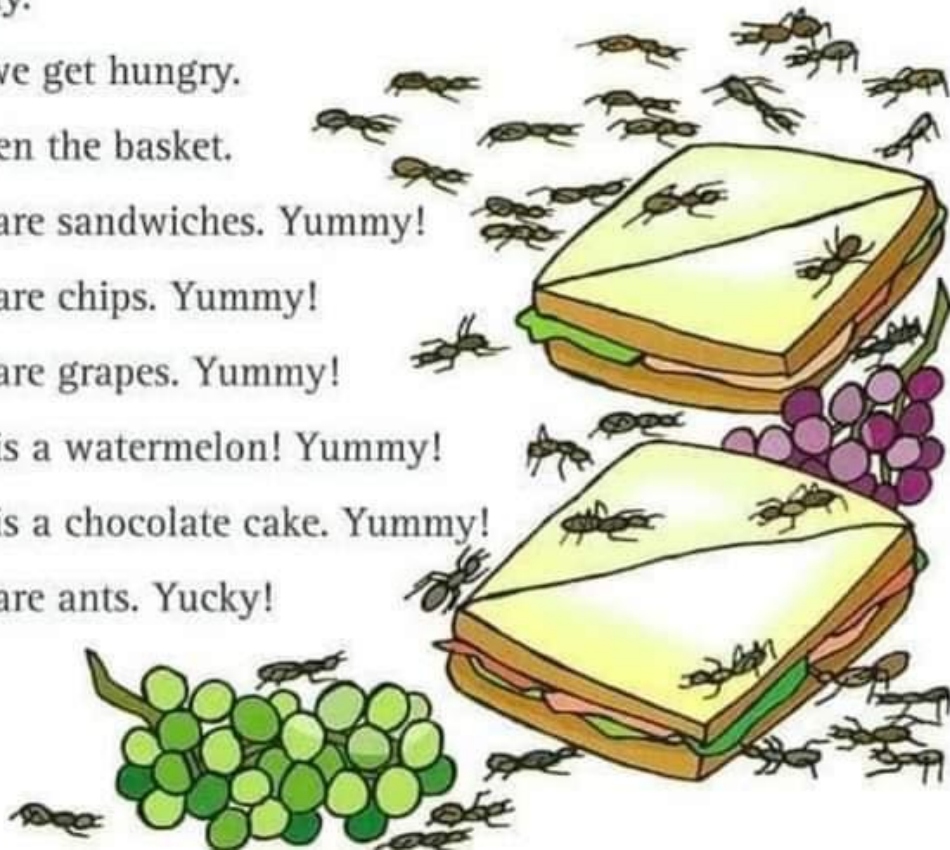
There are chips. Yummy!

This ant is fast.

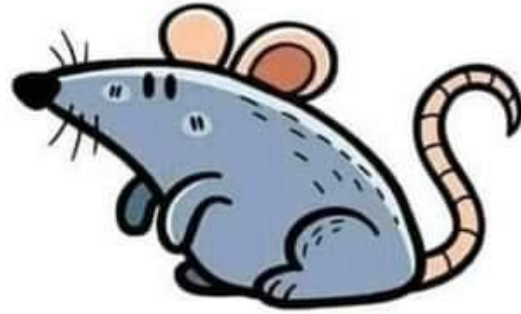
This is a fast ant.

This Is Pat



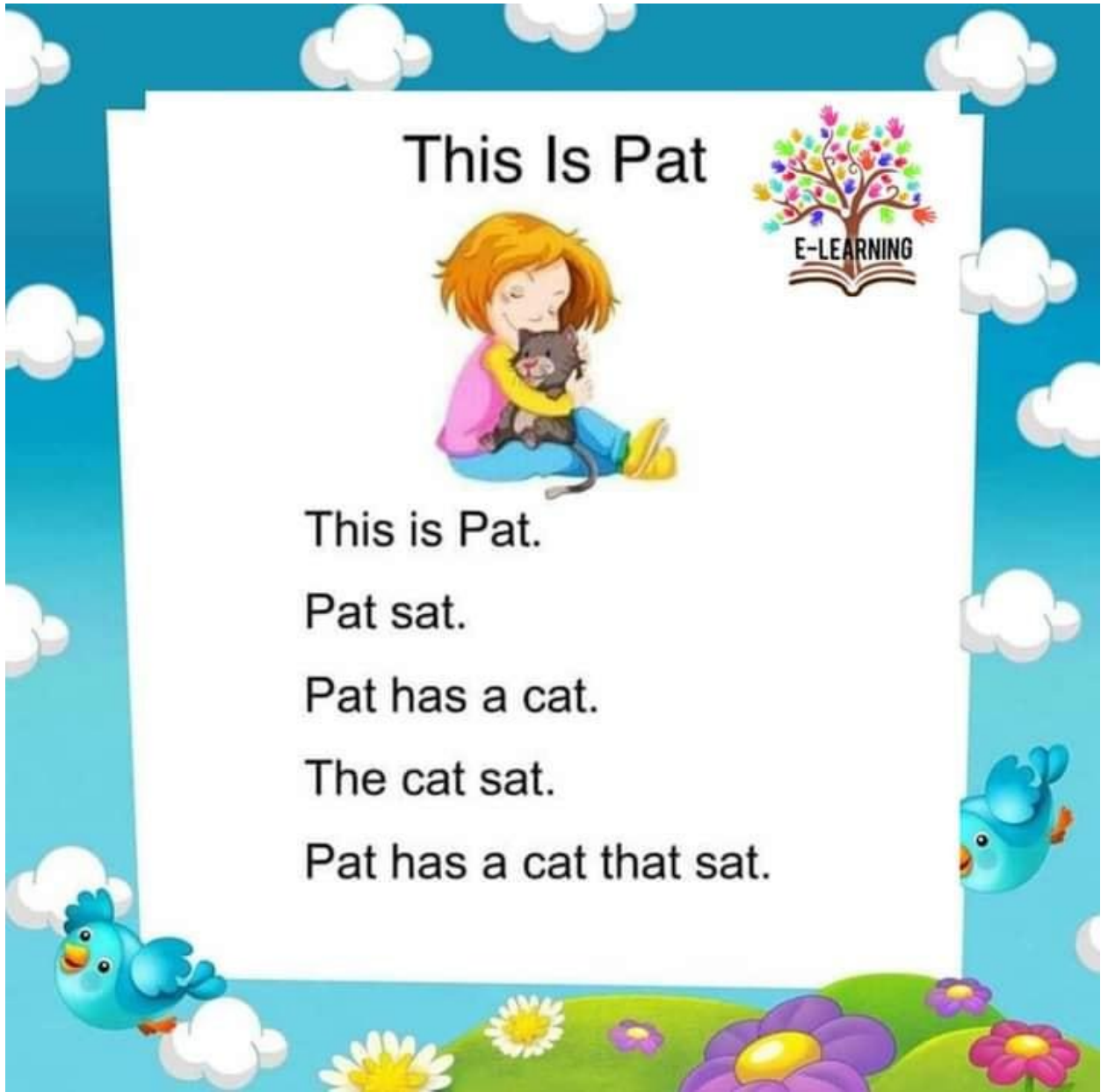
This is Pat.

I sat.

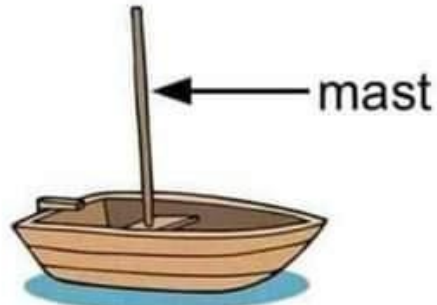

This Is a Cast

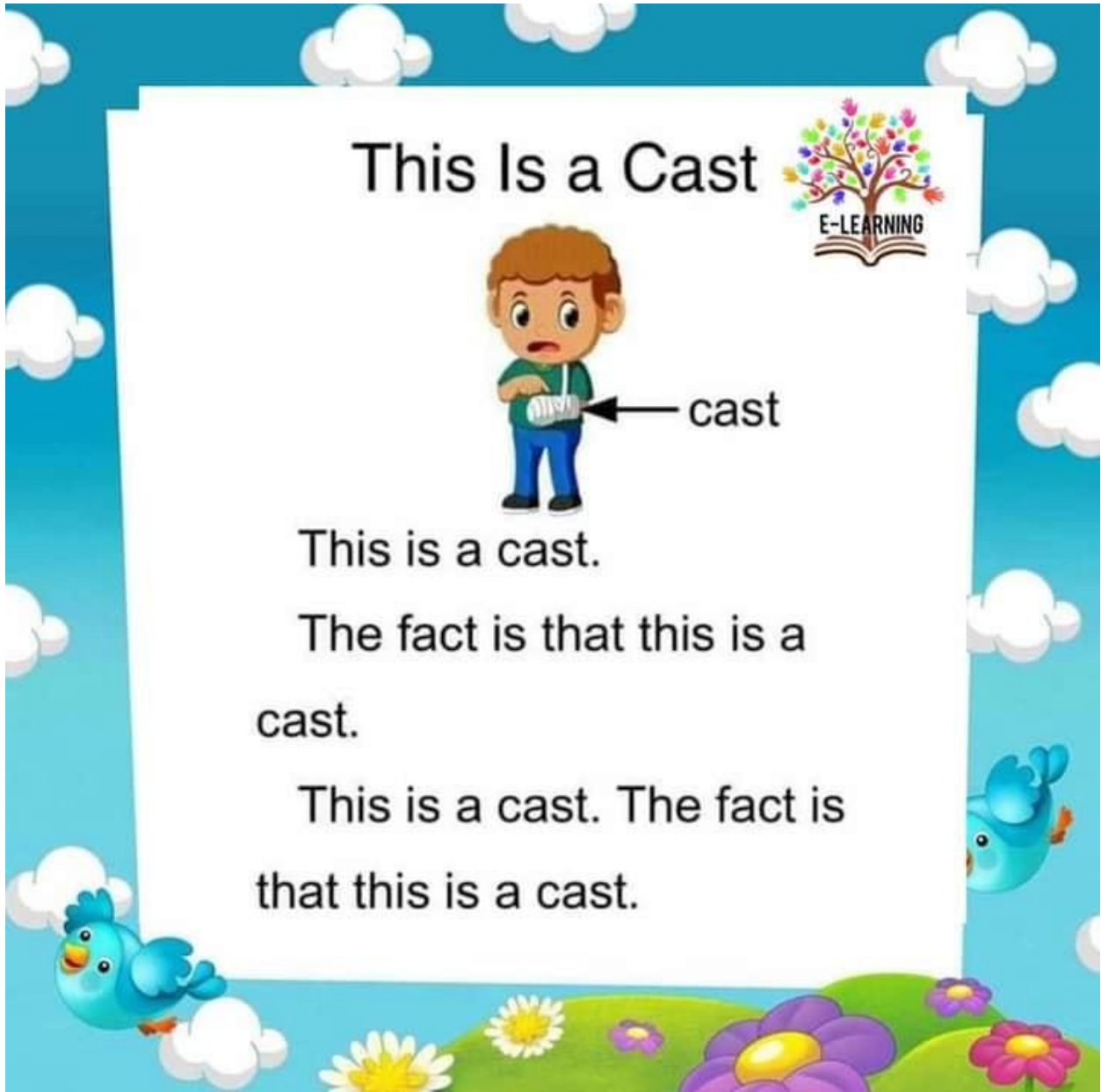
